## JONATHAN LILLEY

A church musician since chorister days at parish church and cathedral in Salisbury, Jonathan Lilley trained at the Royal Academy of Music, and whilst still a first-year student held the organ scholarship at St George's Chapel, Windsor Castle and gained the Fellowship of the Royal College of Organists. His career proper began in

Leeds, where he was Sub-Organist of the then Leeds Parish Church, and worked as choral director and piano accompanist at Leeds College of Music and for numerous choirs around the West Riding of Yorkshire.

Jonathan then moved to Ely Cathedral as full-time Assistant Organist, in which capacity he was principal accompanist to the cathedral choir of boys and men, and integral to the training of the boy choristers and the running of the music department. King's School Ely along with Ely Choral Society and Ely Consort kept him busy as piano and organ accompanist. At Ely he achieved his first concerti – Poulenc's organ concerto with the City of London Sinfonia under Stephen Layton, broadcast from Ely Cathedral by BBC Radio 3, and Mozart's A major piano concerto as part of a concert by Ely Choral Society. He also made his first forays into silent film accompaniment, presenting The Hunchback of Notre Dame and The General in the cathedral, to wide acclaim. He appeared as both organist and pianist on the Ely choir's recordings and broadcasts, and in recital in the cathedral.

Since September 2013 Jonathan has been Director of Music at Waltham Abbey Church, where he leads the Abbey's mixed adult choir and a children's choir known as the Choristers.
