LADY CHAPEL UPDATE – Work on the the Lady Chapel will extend into next week, largely due to the stone steps taking much longer than anticipated to clean. The rotten floor hatches have been repaired and next week the whole parquet will be lightly sanded and oiled. We will also be conserving and reinstating the water damaged altar rails. At the same time we will take the opportunity to conserve an area of parquet in the north aisle, from where we have removed the cupboard and carpet in preparation.

LADY CHAPEL LAUNCH - ANGELS IN EALING - A weekend of celebration is planned to reopen the Chapel on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd October. The programme, which we are calling 'Angels in Ealing', will include a Saturday morning Community Opening Ceremony and Open Morning, followed by a talk on Henry Charles Brewer, who created the Chapel's wonderful painted angels. That evening there will be a launch of Susan Peatfield's exciting new study of the Church, and a talk by the Director of the De Morgan Foundation - an expert on Pre-Raphaelite art. And then on the Sunday, Harvest Mass will be combined with a Blessing Ceremony, followed by suitable and extensive celebration. Full details are on the heritage section of our website.
