To celebrate the completion of the organ console restoration, our Director of Music, Mark James will give a short lunchtime organ recital on Advent Sunday at 1pm. The programme will mark the start of Advent plus some fun arrangements to demonstrate the versatility of our instrument. Lunch will be served in the hall at 12 noon.
