LADY CHAPEL PROJECT UPDATE - St Peter's was recently presented with an etching by the family of Henry Charles Brewer, who created the Lady Chapel's wall paintings in 1928. The large and beautiful picture of Reims Cathedral was created by James Alphege Brewer, younger brother of Henry Charles. The Brewers lived in Acton, and the production of etchings was very much a family enterprise. Our etching was generously donated by a great niece of James Alphege, and it highly likely that her grandfather worked on its production.

We intend to hang the picture in the Lady Chapel, where it will both add resonance to the highly-accomplished Brewer murals, and to the war dead commemorated there, many of whom fell in Northern France. LENT 2022. The programme for Lent is coming together. We will be offering a study course entitled Living in Love and Faith. The course aims to help Christians think more deeply about what it means to be human. It provides a structured and accessible way to engage and reflect upon Living in Love and Faith, a major new exploration of Christian teaching and learning about identity, sexuality, relationships and marriage.

Each session explores one key topic, with an opening reflection about learning together, followed by teaching, time for discussion and Bible study. The sessions end with an invitation to reflect on our learning, bringing it to God in prayer.

The course will be on Tuesday evenings starting on 8th March at 7.30pm.
