SERVICES Under Lockdown 3. Because of high infection numbers in the Borough and the highly infectious nature of the new strain of COVID all places of worship have been asked by Ealing Council to consider closing to public worship and private prayer. After prayer and deliberation, the PCC, responding to the Council's request have decided to Zoom-broadcast services of the Word though this period of lockdown from the Lady Chapel. We have also decided to close the church to private prayer.

LENT 2021: We have been putting together a programme of study, prayer and fellowship for the Lenten Season. 2020 and 2021 have been and continue to be hard. Our aim in our Lent programme 2021 is to offer space to be in the presence of God, to deepen the faith that sustains us and develop tools that will help us in our journey. To that end:
