## **LENT APPEAL 2021 – CHALLENGING YOUTH VIOLENCE**

Youth violence is an issue of great urgency for our time. In 2019, 24 children aged just 17 or younger were murdered with a knife or sharp object. This represents the highest number of children murdered in over a decade.

Youth violence, which is prevalent in London, is the intentional use of physical force or power to threaten or harm others by young people aged between 10-24 years. It can include fighting, bullying, threats with weapons, and gang-related violence. A young person can be involved with youth violence as a victim, offender, or witness.

The Diocese of London Lent Appeal for 2021 will focus on Youth Violence and the causes that contribute to it. It will be raising money to support three chosen charities working to challenge it.
