LADY CHAPEL - Just before Christmas, we received the marvellous news that the Steel Charitable Trust has awarded the Lady Chapel Project a grant of just over £13,000. The gift - the largest so far - comes as a result of a rather wonderful St Peter's connection.

From the 1940s, possibly before, a family named Brooke started attending the Church. Roderick and Muriel and their children lived on Marchwood Crescent, near Ealing Abbey, and were extremely involved in the life of St Peter's. Roderick served as a sidesman, and two of their daughters, Mary and Jenifer, were married here in the 1940s and 1950s. Muriel died in 1965; Roderick remained a member of the congregation until he moved to Anglesey to spend his final years near Mary and her family.

Jenifer's eldest son is a Trustee of the Steel Charitable Trust, and, by chance, spotted St Peter's funding request which we made to the Trust in late summer. We very much hope to use the Trust's gift to mark the Brooke Family's contribution to St Peter's. If anyone can tell us more about Roderick & Muriel, do please let the project team know.

The Lady Chapel Project cost is now c. £65,000 (inc. VAT). Costs have risen significantly due to unforeseen increases in the scope and material prices. Thanks to the Steel Charitable Trust and all our supporters, we now have just c. £6,000 still to find. Look out for regular project updates over the coming weeks.
