ADVENT 2024

Study Group: This year we are reading the Archbishop of York's Advent Book for 2024 'Do Not Be Afraid' by Rachel Mann. Rachel is Archdeacon of Salford and Bolton, a writer, poet, priest, theologian and broadcaster. To quote the cover, "These luminous meditations tell stories of God waiting with us when we're in fear or distress; of coming – bidden or unbidden – to relieve our loneliness; of disconcerting us. Desiring us and surprising us with joy...Most of all they remind us that Jesus Christ comes into the world as one long waited for; as the servant who waits on others; as the one on whom we are, adoringly, called to wait".

The Group will meet on Zoom, staring on Monday 25th November and then moving to Tuesday evenings. Sessions will begin at 7pm and last one hour.
