ANGELS IN EALING - A weekend of celebration - which we are calling 'Angels in Ealing' - is planned to reopen the Chapel on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd October. This will include a Saturday morning community ceremony and open morning, followed by a talk on Henry Charles Brewer, who created the Chapel's wonderful painted angels. That evening there will be a launch of Susan Peatfield's exciting new book of the Church, and a talk by the Director of the De Morgan Foundation - an expert on Pre Raphaelite art. And then on the Sunday, Harvest Mass will be combined with a Blessing Ceremony, followed by celebrations. LADY CHAPEL UPDATE: Work is finally due to start in the Chapel on Monday 18th July. An initial phase will take place over the next few weeks, with the work resuming in early September and completing by the middle of the month. The Chapel will close tomorrow. LADY CHAPEL: THE ROYAL CONNECTION - Did you know that Henry Charles Brewer, who carried out the Lady Chapel wall paintings attended and painted the Coronation of George VI. Or that Edward Arthur Fellowes Prynne, whose oil painting hangs next to the office door, was commissioned by Queen Victoria to paint the Duke of Edinburgh in 1891?
