Reflections on Prayers - A Course

Without missing a beat, he offered them the words we have repeated so often throughout our lives and have come to know as "The Lord's Prayer (Luke 11:1-4; Matthew 6:5-15)." But apart from that, in the Bible, we can find many other examples of both people living in prayer and of prayer itself. Some of them are especially dear to us.
