The completion of the organ rebuild will be celebrated by a recital given by

international concert organist Martin Baker. Martin was Master of Music at Westminster Cathedral and previously organist of both St Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey. His programme will include music by Walton, Whitlock, JS Bach, and Widor, plus one of his legendary improvisations. The recital falls on the eve of Dedication Sunday, the 130th anniversary of the church and organ. Tickets now available from Mark or the Parish office or by programme, at the door on the day.

LADY CHAPEL NEWS - Over the last week we have had the two beautiful Lady Chapel oak floorstanding candle holders conserved. The work was made possible by a generous member of the congregation and was carried out locally by King & Son in Hanwell. The candle holders should be back in situ by Sunday looking fantastic — do take a look! This is part of an ongoing programme of activity to further enhance the Chapel following last summer's restoration. Other work includes repairing the damaged reredos and WWII Memorial, recovering the seats - thanks to Sarah Hare - and potentially installing a storage cupboard. Do ask if you'd like to know more.
