LADY CHAPEL PROJECT UPDATE - St Peter's was recently presented with an etching by the family of Henry Charles Brewer, who created the Lady Chapel's wall paintings in 1928. The large and beautiful picture of Reims Cathedral was created by James Alphege Brewer, younger brother of Henry Charles. The Brewers lived in Acton, and the production of etchings was very much a family enterprise. Our etching was generously donated by a great niece of James Alphege, and it highly likely that her grandfather worked on its production.

We intend to hang the picture in the Lady Chapel, where it will both add resonance to the highly-accomplished Brewer murals, and to the war dead commemorated there, many of whom fell in Northern France.
