ANNUAL PARISH CHURCH MEETING (APCM) - Sunday 11th May 2025. It is that time of year again when we prepare for our APCM. Thank you to all those who have submitted reports.

We are looking for candidates for election to the position of Churchwarden and the Parochial Church Council. If you are eligible and would like to stand, please complete the necessary nomination forms and pass them to Fr David or Cornelia Harding, our PCC Secretary.

EASTER FLOWERS. Contributions to the cost of providing flowers for Easter are very welcome. Gifts can be left at the parish office or given to Jane Campbell or Ann Lazarow.

FIRST COMMUNION CLASSES. We are planning our First Communion classes for May this year. Classes are open to children from YrI and above. They must be either baptised or planning for baptism before Pentecost (8th June). If you are interested or want to know more please speak to Fr David.

CONFIRMATION CLASSES. Because we admit children to communion before confirmation (First Communion), it is our practice at St Peter's to encourage young adults as well as grown adults to consider confirmation if they have not already been confirmed. If this is something you would like to consider confirmation please speak to Fr David who is planning classes for 2025. Confirmation is a special service where the candidate confirms for themselves the promises of faith made on their behalf at their baptism. If you are an unbaptised adult then we would prepare you for baptism and confirmation at the same time.

DIGITAL ORDERS OF SERVICE. This can be emailed to you during the week, allowing you to download the order onto your digital device (smartphone; tablet etc). This saves on paper and printing. If you would like to do this and don't yet receive the order of service digitally, please contact the parish office and Lesley will be very happy to add you to our list.

PARISH GIVING SCHEME:

The PCC want everyone to move their regular offering to the Parish Giving Scheme (PGS). This is a system run by the Church of England to help the efficient gathering our financial support whilst arranging Gift Aid collection from HMRC. Rather than paying directly into the church account we pay our offering to PGS. It is collected from our account on the Ist of the month and paid into the church account on the I0th of the month. The Gift Aid (if eligible) is then paid into the church account a couple of days later. This allows us to keep completely up to date with our income stream rather than waiting to be able to make Gift Aid application to HMRC every three to six months. It is so simple to do. Just go on the website and follow the instructions.

You can also elect to have your offering increase each year by the rate of inflation. Maybe too, whilst moving over to PGS you could consider increasing your regular monthly offering.

Once you have opened your PGS account remember to cancel your standing order to the parish after the final payment has been made.
