LADY CHAPEL UPDATE – Conservation of the wall painting and repainting the space is now complete and the scaffold removed. The contractors will return in a few weeks to restore the parquet and stone floor, as well as reinstalling the beautiful Arts & Crafts altar rails. Meanwhile, conservation of our Edward Arthur Fellowes Prynne painting continues in North London. For the first time in decades we can see the extraordinary colour and detail of the picture, and we are learning huge amounts about how Fellowes Prynne worked. And while the picture is away, we have taken the opportunity of repainting the wall where it hangs. Please consider supporting the project. With a funding gap of just a few thousand, donations of any size will make a big difference.

LADY CHAPEL LAUNCH - ANGELS IN EALING - A weekend of celebration is planned to reopen the Chapel on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd October. The programme, which we are calling 'Angels in Ealing', will include a Saturday morning Community Opening Ceremony and Open Morning, followed by a <u>talk on Henry Charles Brewer</u>, who created the Chapel's wonderful painted angels. That evening there will be a <u>launch of Susan Peatfield's exciting</u> <u>new study of the Church, and a talk by the Director of the De Morgan Foundation</u> - an expert on Pre-Raphaelite art. And then on the Sunday, Harvest Mass will be combined with a Blessing Ceremony, followed by suitable and extensive celebration. <u>Full details are on the heritage section of</u> <u>our website</u>.
