ORGAN UPDATE - The organ is now back and playable, after delays with both companies working for the organ builders on the keys and electronics due to a national shortage in phosphor bronze. Final electrics works will follow next week.

LADY CHAPEL WORKS - The main Lady Chapel restoration is now complete. We hope you agree that the preserved space and conserved oil painting look magnificent. A number of final elements will be finished over the coming weeks - including the installation of a new mat, radiators and storage.
