EALING CHURCHES WINTER NIGHT SHELTER - St Peter's is helping to host the homeless as part of the Ealing Churches Winter Night Shelter programme (ECWNS) as we have done in previous years. We will give up to 14 of the homeless dinner and bed and breakfast for the night in the church on each Thursday evening between **27th November and 18th December** inclusive. This year we are again doing an additional night on Friday 28th November. To do this we need volunteers to cook, look after our guests both in the evening and overnight, and then provide breakfast before getting the sheets washed and the equipment driven over to the next church. Sounds like a lot but we split it up into manageable parcels and the more that volunteer the easier it gets!
