PARISH GIVING SCHEME:

If you are on our email list you will have received a letter from me about th3 Parish Giving Scheme. The PCC would like to update the way we make our regular offering for the work of God in our parish. The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is a system run by the Church of England that helps to efficiently gathering our financial support whilst arranging Gift Aid collection from HMRC. Rather than paying directly into the church account we pay our offering to PGS. It is collected from our account on the Ist of the month and paid into the

church account on the 10th of the month. The Gift Aid (if eligible) is then paid into the church account a couple of days later. This allows us to keep completely up to date with our income stream rather than waiting to be able to make Gift Aid application to HMRC every three to six months.

It is so simple to do. Just go on the website and follow the instructions.

You can also elect to have your offering increase each year by the rate of inflation. Maybe too, whilst moving over to PGS you could consider increasing your regular monthly offering.

Once you have opened your PGS account remember to cancel your standing order to the parish.

LENT COURSE 2025: This year we are looking at Paul's Letters from Prison. After his imprisonment in Rome he wrote four significant letters to the churches which have been included in the New Testament canon. In our short course we will hear something of modern scholars thought behind the letters and then explore them together. You do not need any particular skills, just a desire to learn more.

Our first session will be on Thursday 6th March with the next four sessions being on the Tuesday 18th, 25th March; 1st & 8th April at 7.30pm.
