LADY CHAPEL LAUNCH - ANGELS IN EALING - A weekend of celebration is planned to reopen the Chapel on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd October. The programme, which we are calling 'Angels in Ealing', will include a Saturday morning Community Opening Ceremony and Open Morning, followed by a talk on Henry Charles Brewer, who created the Chapel's wonderful painted angels. That evening there will be a launch of Susan Peatfield's exciting new study of the Church, and a talk by the Director of the De Morgan Foundation - an expert on Pre-Raphaelite art. And then on the Sunday, Harvest Mass will be combined with a Blessing Ceremony, followed by suitable and extensive celebration. Full details are on the heritage section of our website.

LADY CHAPEL UPDATE – WORKS STARTS! Work has now finally started on the conservation of our Lady Chapel. On Monday, Ana Logreira, our Lead Conservator from Cliveden Conservation came on site to prepare the space, and on Tuesday morning the scaffolding arrived. A three-layer scaffold has now been constructed in the sanctuary, allowing Ana to access the wall paintings, ceiling and reredos. A scaffolding tower has also been built to give access to the rest of the walls and ceiling. Cleaning trials on a section of the painted ceiling have shown that we can expect a significant improvement in the brightness of the colour and gilding.

This initial phase will last for three weeks, with Ana returning in late-August to complete the remaining work, including preservation of the stone and parquet floor. In the meantime, next Thursday, the oil painting hanging next to the office door will be de-hung and transported for conservation in north London.
