**EALING CHURCHES WINTER NIGHT SHELTER 2024.** St Peter's is again helping to host the homeless as part of the Ealing Churches Winter Night Shelter programme (ECWNS). We will give up to 14 of the homeless dinner and bed and breakfast for the night in the church on each Thursday evening between 28<sup>th</sup> November and 19<sup>th</sup> December inclusive. This year we are hosting an additional night on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November. To do this we need volunteers to cook, look after our guests both in the evening and overnight, and then provide breakfast before getting the sheets washed and the equipment driven over to the next church. Sounds like a lot but we split it up into manageable parcels and the more that volunteer the easier it gets! ## ADVENT 2024

**Study Group:** This year's Advent Study Group will be reading the Archbishop of York's Advent Book for 2024 'Do Not Be Afraid' by Rachel Mann. Rachel is Archdeacon of Salford and Bolton, Canon of Manchester Cathedral, a writer, poet, priest, theologian and broadcaster. To quote the cover, "These luminous meditations tell stories of God waiting with us when we're in fear or distress; of coming – bidden or unbidden – to relieve our loneliness; of disconcerting us. Desiring us and surprising us with joy...Most of all they remind us that Jesus Christ comes into the world as one long waited for; as the servant who waits on others; as the one on whom we are, adoringly, called to wait".

The Group will meet on Zoom, starting on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November and then moving to Tuesday evenings. Sessions will begin at 7pm.
