Further details of the restoration and the 3 phases will be given at the recital with big screen projection for a close up view of the organist's hands and feet. Tickets are available after the service at £10 each with all proceeds supporting the third phase of works.

ADVENT COURSE 2022 – SLEEPERS WAKE: Getting Serious about climate change. This is a four session course (from Monday 28th November, 7pm initially on Zoom) following the latest book by Nicholas Holtam, retired Bishop of Salisbury and former CofE lead on Creation Care. Using scripture, art, science and poetry, Fr Nicholas explores the burning questions surrounding climate change and the Christian response, delving into theology and spirituality to help us think and pray more deeply on the subject.
