### THE NEW BISHOP OF WILLESDEN HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED!

It was announced this week, at Twyford High School, that The Revd Canon Lusa Nsenga-Ngoy, currently Black and Minority Ethnic Mission and Ministry Enabler in the Diocese of Leicester is to be the next Bishop of Willesden. Fr Lusa was educated in Theology at the Faculté Universitaire de Théologie Protestante, Brussels and trained for ministry at Cranmer Hall, Durham. Ordained in 2008 he served his title at All Saints, Staplehurst in the Diocese of Canterbury. He became Vicar of St Aidan, Gravesend in 2012, moving to his present post in 2017. He is married to Mirjam who works as Discipleship Officer at Leicester Cathedral. They have three young children. Fr Lusa will be consecrated at St Paul's Cathedral on Tuesday 25th January 2022.
