LADY CHAPEL - Edward Fellowes Prynne Painting Discovery - In 1922, St Peter's was presented with a highly accomplished oil painting of *Christ Before Pilot*, by the leading late Pre-Raphaelite artist, Edward Fellowes Prynne. Prynne and his family lived at 1 Woodville Road for many years, and attended St Peter's. Following his death, Prynne' death, his widow Emma donated the painting in his memory. Over Christmas we made contact with descendants of Prynne in New Zealand, who have provided us with a great deal of information and pictures of the artist and his family. This includes, remarkably, a photograph of his studio shortly before his death, in which, in which a section of St Peter's painting can clearly be seen! A copy of the photograph can be found at the back of the Church in the Lady Chapel display.

We plan to conserve the painting and its frame as part of the Lady Chapel Project. This will include cleaning and revarnishing the canvas, installing non-reflective glass, and installing a light fitting – costing up to £4,000.
