ORGAN UPDATE - The organ is now back and playable, after delays with both companies working for the organ builders on the keys and electronics due to a national shortage in phosphor bronze. Final electrics works are being completed.

NEW CHURCH HISTORY - The new study of St Peter's by Susan Peatfield and its Lady Chapel is now complete. The book - which includes beautiful professional photography - is available at the back of the church, with copies costing a very reasonable £8.

ADVENT SUNDAY - NOVEMBER 27TH - ORGAN RECITAL. To celebrate the completion of the organ console restoration, our Director of Music, Mark James will give a short lunchtime organ recital on Advent Sunday at Ipm. The programme will mark the start of Advent plus some fun arrangements to demonstrate the versatility of our instrument. Lunch will be served in the hall at 12 noon. Further details of the restoration and the 3 phases will be given at the recital with big screen projection for a close up view of the organist's hands and feet. Tickets are available after the service and from the parish office at £10 each with all proceeds supporting the third phase of works.

ADVENT COURSE 2022 – SLEEPERS WAKE: Getting Serious about climate change. This is a four session course (from Monday 28th November, 7pm @ the Vicarage) following the latest book by Nicholas Holtam, retired Bishop of Salisbury and former CofE lead on Creation Care. Using scripture, art, science and poetry, Fr Nicholas explores the burning questions surrounding climate change and the Christian response, delving into theology and spirituality to help us think and pray more deeply on the subject.
