**SERVICES Under Lockdown 3.** Because of rapidly rising infection numbers in the Borough and the highly infectious nature of the new strain of COViD all places of worship have been asked by Ealing Council to consider closing to public worship and private prayer. After prayer and deliberation, the PCC, responding to the Council's request have decided to Zoom-broadcast services of the Word though this period of lockdown from the Lady Chapel. We have also decided to close the church to private prayer.
