Reflections on Prayers – A Course

Observing the Lord Jesus turning so often to prayer in his ministry, the disciples asked him to teach them to pray. Without missing a beat, he offered them the words we have repeated so often throughout our lives and have come to know as “The Lord’s Prayer (Luke 11:1-4; Matthew 6:5-15).”

But apart from that, in the Bible, we can find many other examples of both people living in prayer and of prayer itself. Some of them are especially dear to us.

During our four meetings, we will combine the theoretical and practical aspects. We will not only talk about the essential Christian prayers by trying to understand their context and meaning, but we will also pray using these words.
