BEST FEET FORWARD - Wednesday, 14th February - CITY OF LONDON CHURCHES WALK - all day/3 miles approx. 10:30 am start from All Hallows by the Tower, Leader: Rev Margaret Joachim. Meet at the first church on the walk - All Hallows by the Tower, Byward Street, at 10.30; finish at St Bartholomew's, Smithfield, at about 4pm. Lunch stop at a suitable spot somewhere around Leadenhall Market. This is a gentle amble with a bookish flavour which covers about a mile as the crow flies (and probably about three times that on the ground), and visits 13 city churches, covering 46 of the original 111 city parishes. This is being run predominantly for people on the Book History MA course at London University but is open to St Peter's Best Feet Forward folks.
