ST PAULS CATHEDRAL - Maundy Thursday Chrism Mass, 10.30am, 24th March with Renewal of Ordination Vows and the Blessing of Oils.

EALING PASSION GOOD FRIDAY 25th March 2016 – Gather at Haven Green for 9.55am. There will be hymns/songs, gospel readings and prayers from 10-10.15am. At 10.15am the procession, led by a small group of soldiers with Jesus carrying his cross, will walk onto The Broadway at the

pedestrian crossing just south of the roundabout and proceed past Ealing Broadway station and into the grounds of Christ the Saviour Church. From approximately 10.45am in the grounds of Christ the Saviour there will be a re-enactment of the gospel events of the crucifixion of Jesus. The event will conclude at approximately 11.15am.
