ST PAULS CATHEDRAL - Maundy Thursday Chrism Mass, 10.30am, 2nd April with Renewal of Ordination Vows and the Blessing of Oils.

EALING PASSION GOOD FRIDAY 2015 - This year all churches are invited to congregate on Haven Green for 9.55am on Good Friday 3rd April. There will be hymns/songs, gospel readings and prayers from 10-10.15am. At 10.15am the procession, led by a small group of soldiers with Jesus carrying his cross, will walk onto The Broadway at the pedestrian crossing just south of the roundabout and proceed past Ealing Broadway station and into the grounds of Christ the Saviour Church. From approximately 10.45am in the grounds of Christ the Saviour there will be a reenactment of the gospel events of the crucifixion of Jesus with dialogue, music and song. The event will conclude at approximately 11.15am where a small piece of bread will be offered to passes by as a symbol of God's love for the world embodied in Christ. Those attending are asked to line the north side of Uxbridge Road and to bring things to make a load noise (sticks to bang together or bang on the traffic railings, tin cans etc.)
