**BEST FEET FORWARD - Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> June, LEE VALLEY CIRCULAR TRAIL - 2 TO 3 HOURS/4.5 MILES** approx. 9:15 am start from Ealing Broadway Station. Leaders Rosanna and Richard Fullerton.
