The walk will end in Rickmansworth at The Pennsylvanian pub (Wetherspoons) where those who wish can have lunch. Journey home from Rickmansworth is by Metropolitan Line to Northwood Hills, 282 bus to Northolt, Central Line to Perivale and 297 bus to Ealing Broadway. Rickmansworth is Zone 7 - covered by the Freedom Pass or Over 60 Pass.
